The goal of this afternoon program is to stop what is widely known as the **summer slide**. As parents approach the summer break, many are thinking about the family vacation, how to keep children engaged in activities at home, the abrupt changes to everyone's schedule—and how to juggle it all. What they might not be focusing on is how much educational ground their children could lose during the two-month break from school, particularly when it comes to reading. Experts agree that children who read during the summer gain reading skills, while those who do not often slide backward. Within this program, students will receive reading, writing and math instruction to maintain their current level of academic ability and support an increase in any areas of need, in effort to prevent an academic back-slide

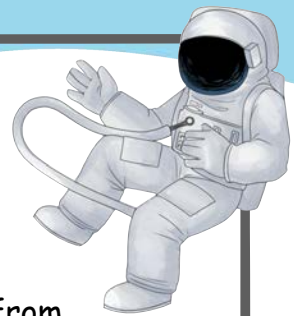
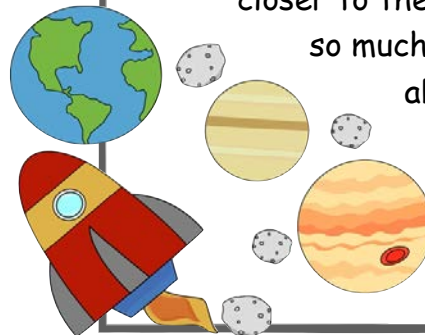

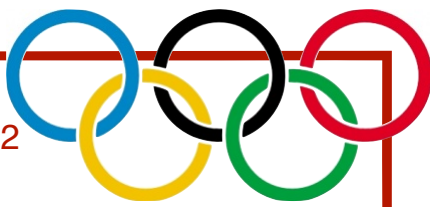

Camp Olympics

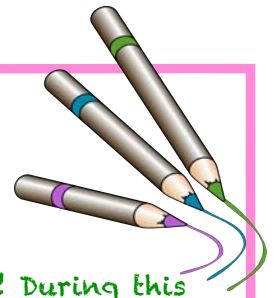

Splash w/ S.T.E.A.M.!

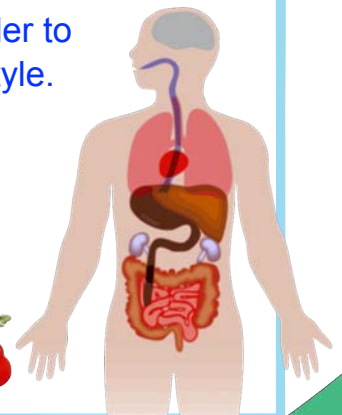

Get ready to move! During this healthy living week, campers will learn the importance of eating healthy and the importance of physical activities in order to maintain a healthy lifestyle.

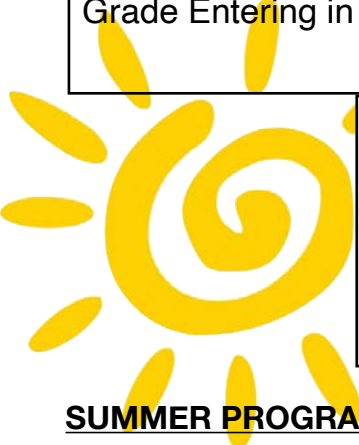
