What they might not be focusing on is how much educational ground their children could lose during the two-month break from school, particularly when it comes to reading. Experts agree that children who read during the summer gain reading skills, while those who do not often slide backward. Within this program, students will receive reading, writing and math instruction to maintain their current level of academic ability and support an increase in any areas of need, in effort to prevent an academic back-slide

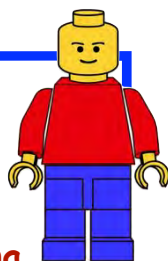
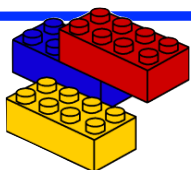


Week 3

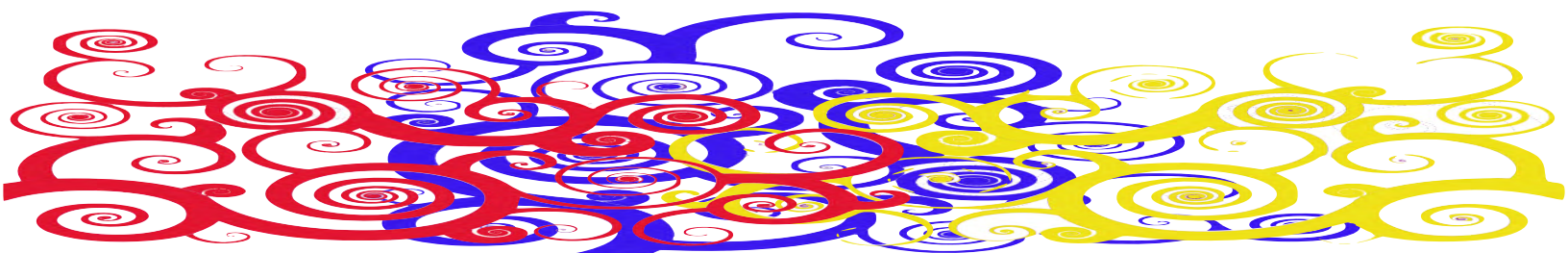
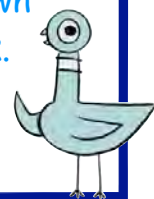
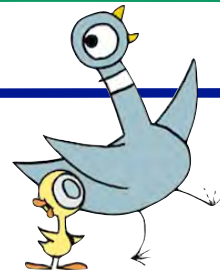


Week 4

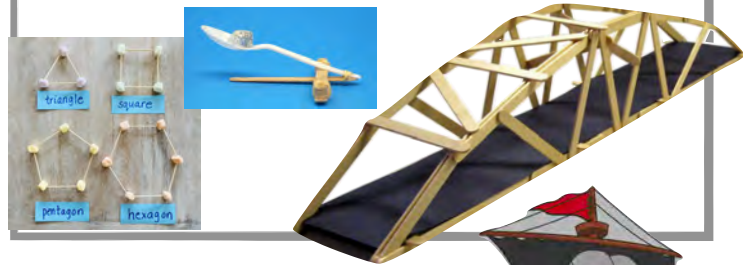

Week 6 ~ S.T.E.A.M. Lab with Sarah

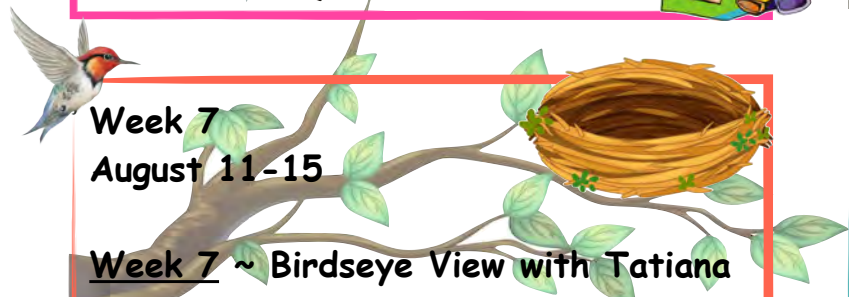

Week 7 ~ Birdseye View with Tatiana

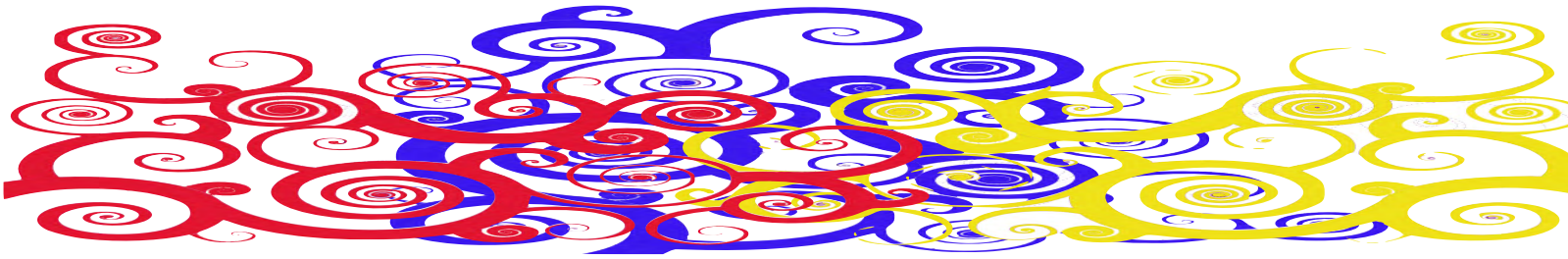

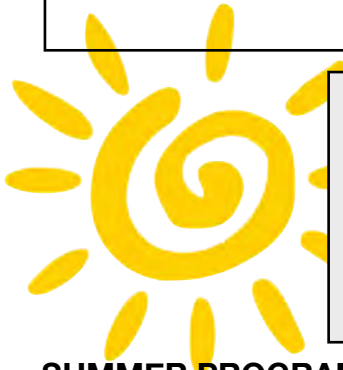
